

Loan Periods: The loan period is 21 days for all items except for DVDs and magazines. These items are checked out for 7 days, TV series for 14 days. Items can be renewed by phone or online (see front of brochure for contact information). If an item is on reserve it may not be renewed.

- 2 renewals are permitted as long as there are no requests on an item.

- Fines/Fees over \$2.00 can be paid online with a debit/credit card through SmartPay.
- Computer use requires a library card. A patron will not be able to use the computer or check out with fines over \$5.00.

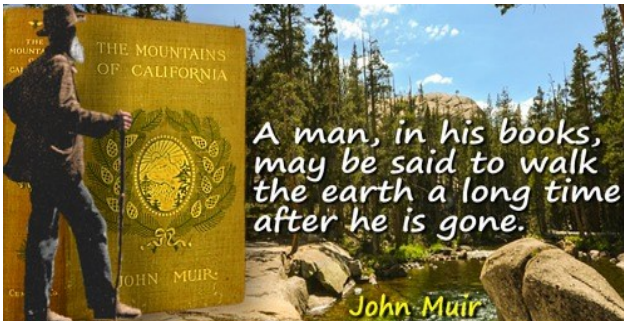

Libby App (an OverDrive product)

Libby is a new app released by OverDrive. It has the same collection of titles as the OverDrive app - it's just an improved way to access the same digital library collection. Libby is compatible with: Kindle Fire, Macs, PCs, and Windows mobile devices.



Whether on the web, a tablet, your mobile device you can browse digital shelves curated by your library or filtering by genres that interest you.

Getting a Library Card:

Welcome! To get a library card, simply fill out an application at the Circulation desk and present a current form of government issued picture I.D. that displays your current mailing address. A parent or legal guardian will need to sign for you if you are under 14. Your first library cards is free; a replacement card is \$2. Your library card is required for all transactions.
